WHAT OPPORTUNITIES ARE AVAILABLE?

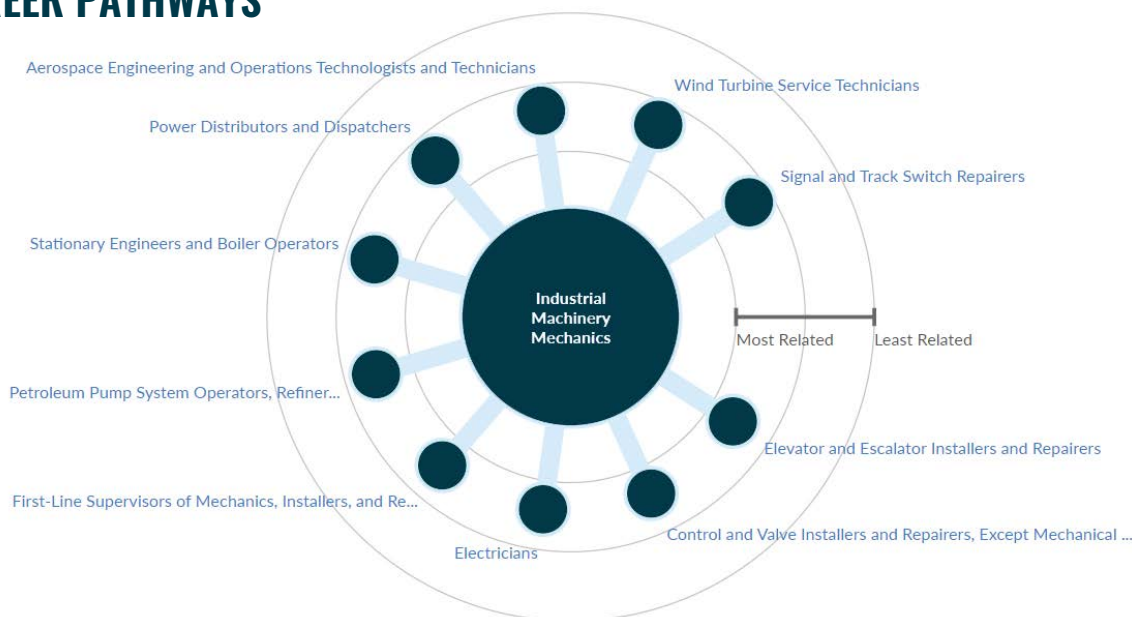
The demand for Industrial Machinery Mechanics is strong and growing in the region, with steady year-over-year job growth and stable openings in Southeast Michigan. Industrial machinery mechanics, machinery maintenance workers, and millwrights install, maintain, and repair factory equipment and other industrial machinery. Most work full time in manufacturing facilities. However, they may be on call and work night or weekend shifts. Overtime is common.

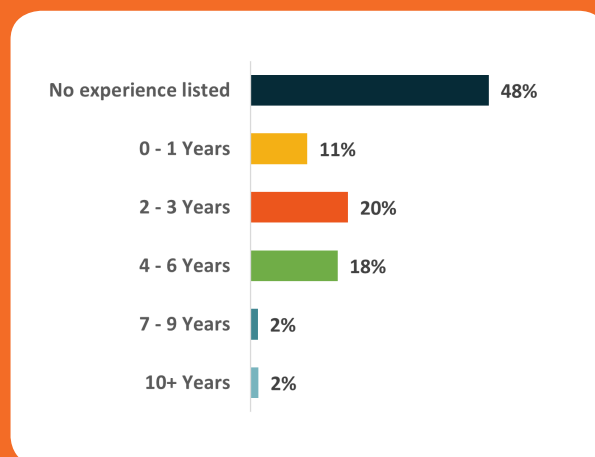
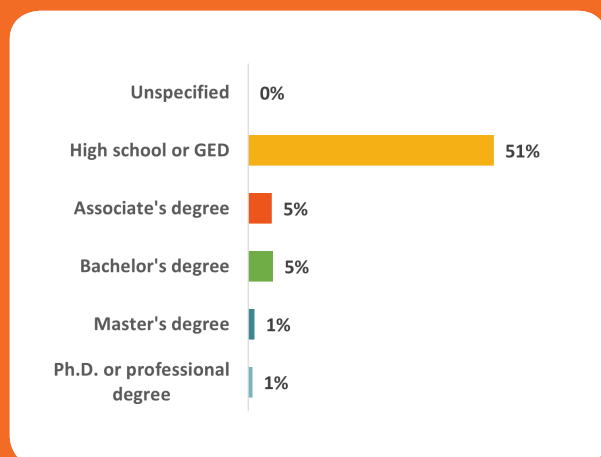

WHAT EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE WILL I NEED?

The positions posted for Industrial Machinery Mechanics seldom require a high level of education or experience. A high school diploma or GED was found to be required in 51% of postings, while Associate's and Bachelor's degrees were only required in only 10% of postings. This characteristic is also reflected in the required experience, with "no experience listed" commanding 48% of posts.

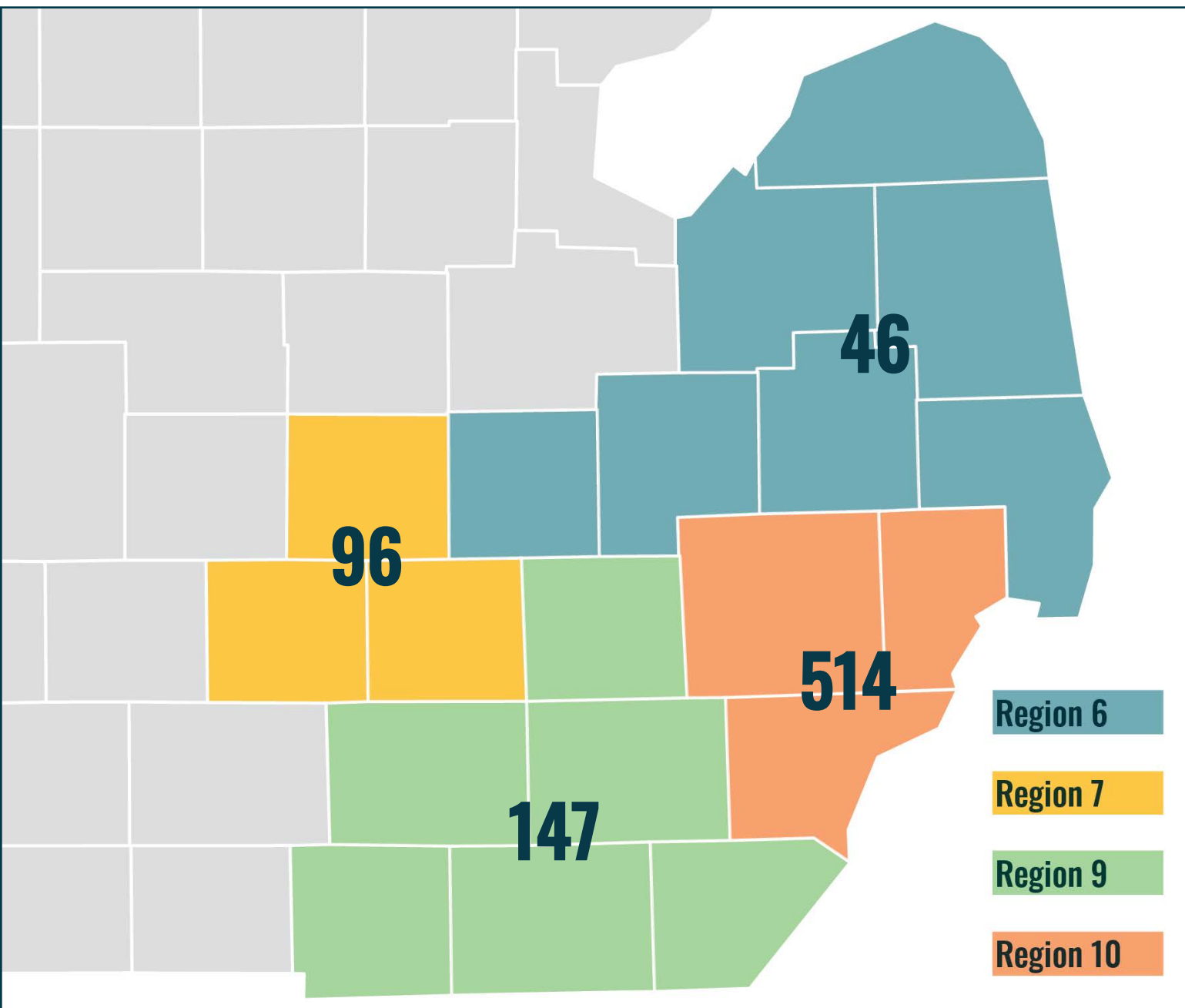
