WHAT ARE CAREER PROFILES?

The Workforce Intelligence Network (WIN) for Southeast Michigan has created **data snapshots** on specific occupations that provide information about **wages, employment projections, and recent job postings**. They are a great tool for **workforce planning, career counseling, and program development**. Profiles can be created for specific occupations supported by ISD programs within the served region.

WHO IS WIN?

- The **U.S. Department of Labor** has recognized WIN as one of the **top workforce collaboratives in the nation**. WIN is a partnership of nine community colleges and seven Michigan Works! agencies.
- The WIN mission is to **help cultivate a cohesive talent system by facilitating data-driven workforce solutions to ensure responsiveness to changing labor market demands**.

WHO IS THE WIN RESEARCH TEAM?

WIN **gathers, analyzes, and distributes real-time labor supply-and-demand intelligence** on workforce needs and characteristics specific to the southeast Michigan region.

- Step 1:** Email info@winintelligence.org to let us know your interest
- Step 2:** Meet with the WIN Research Team to discuss timeline, scope, and specific needs related to profile development.
- Step 3:** Execute contract agreement to initiate the project.
- Step 4:** WIN Research Team begins development of profiles based on agreed scope and timeline.
- Step 5:** Draft profiles submitted to ISD for review and feedback. Revisions are made based on provided input.
- Step 6:** Final profiles delivered to the organization. Contract obligations fulfilled upon delivery.
