

#### BUSINESS AND FINANCE OCCUPATION GROUP

Jobs in the Business and Finance occupation group can be found in nearly every type of establishment throughout the city. These workers require strong mathematical and accounting abilities along with project management and planning skills. Workers in this occupation group are in high demand in Detroit.



#### Business and Finance Education and Experience

The Business and Finance occupation group offers high paying job opportunities for workers. A Bachelor's degree is the most in-demand education level in Q3, as noted in 3,877 postings. A Master's degree is the second most in-demand education level with 986 postings, while 1,481 postings do not specify any education level. Many Business and Finance occupation postings do not specify a required length of experience. Almost half of the postings list a requirement of two to six years of experience.

# Annual Labor Market Highlights (2024)

**Labor Force Growth:** In 2024, the WIN region added **45,846** individuals to the labor force and **21,620** workers to employment. During the same period, the State of Michigan added **78,417** individuals to the labor force and **44,667** workers to employment.

**Unemployment Rate:** The unemployment rate stood at **4.5%** for both the WIN region and the State of Michigan—nearly matching pre-pandemic levels of 4.2% and 4.1%, respectively.

Job Postings: Job postings declined in 2024 compared to 2023.

- In Q4 2024, the WIN region averaged 133,682 postings per month, down from 143,630 in Q3.
- The State of Michigan averaged 200,547 postings per month in Q4 2024, down from 213,667 in Q3.

**Top Occupational Demand:** Among the 11 occupational groups analyzed, **Customer Service remained the highest-demand sector**, with **60,310** postings in Q4 2024 in the WIN region and **290,782** postings statewide across 2024.


**Educational Demand Trends:** In the WIN region, job postings **most frequently listed a Bachelor's degree** as the minimum requirement, while in the State of Michigan overall, **High School diplomas were most commonly required**. However, the demand for these two education levels remains relatively close in both regions.

**State of Michigan (2014 - 2024)** 




# Annual Labor Force, Employment, Unemployment Rate, WIN Region (2014 - 2024)













### **In-Demand Education Levels**






# Michigan Commuting Patterns

Where State of Michigan Residents Work


#### Where State of Michigan Workers Live




